

CHAPTER 232: CEMETERIES

Cross Reference—As to prohibited night parking in cemeteries, see §355.110.

ARTICLE I. GENERALLY

SECTION 232.010: PLANTING AND REMOVAL OF SHRUBBERY

No plants or shrubbery of any kind may be planted in the cemeteries within the City unless prior written approval is obtained from the superintendent of the cemeteries. The superintendent of the cemeteries is hereby given the right to remove any plants or shrubbery now located in the cemeteries which he feels will detract from the beauty of the cemeteries.

SECTION 232.020: REMOVAL OF TEMPORARY GRAVE MARKERS

All temporary grave markers which are placed at grave sites in the cemeteries shall be removed by the City within one (1) year. (CC 1969 §5A-2; Ord. No. 2066 §2, 3-11-74)

SECTION 232.030: FENCES AROUND PLOTS—PROHIBITED

No fence of any kind shall be erected or maintained on or around any grave or plot within the cemeteries. (CC 1969 §5A-3; Ord. No. 2066 §3, 3-11-74)

SECTION 232.040: REMOVAL OF FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS, ETC.

The City shall have the right to remove any flower arrangement or wreath after they have become weather worn and no longer add to the beauty of the cemeteries.

SECTION 232.050: REGULATIONS FOR THE ERECTION OF MONUMENTS

All monuments and stones erected within any cemetery within the City must be set in concrete. The top of the base of each monument must be level with the ground and the top of the base must be at least four (4) inches larger than the bottom of the monument. All monuments which are erected in said cemeteries must be in line with other monuments in the cemetery and must comply with the set back lines located on the plat of the cemetery. Before any monuments can be erected in the cemeteries the superintendent must give his approval as to the type and location thereof.

SECTION 232.060: BURIAL OF ANIMALS IN CITY CEMETERIES—PROHIBITED

The cemeteries within the City shall be used to bury humans only and no dog or cat or other animals shall be buried therein. (CC 1969 §5A-6; Ord. No. 2066 §6, 3-11-74)

SECTION 232.070: CITY NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE TO MONUMENTS OR GRAVES

The City shall not be responsible for any vandalism or destruction of any monuments or graves located in any cemetery within the City. (CC 1969 §5A-7; Ord. No. 2066 §7, 3-11-74)
